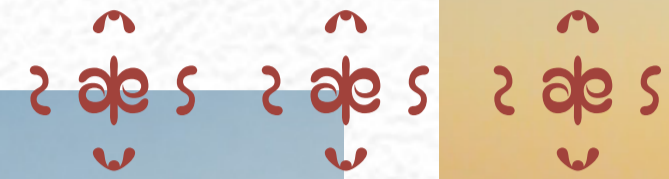

## Design to Feel Different

The architecture of SOMA is shaped by its setting.



A low-rise silhouette that follows the coastline rather than competing with it. Soft, sculptural forms that take their cues from the materials of the sea. Sun-bleached stone, sand, weathered timber. Generous balconies on every home. A rooftop that turns the building's highest point into its most social.

Inside, expansive glazing and three-metre ceilings draw daylight deep into the residences and frame the horizon as part of everyday life.

An intimate collection of 44 residences. A scale of living rarely found in Dubai and the reason SOMA feels like somewhere you truly belong.

## Where Home Begins

Olive trees, soft light, and the slow start of a day.

Each space at SOMA is designed around a different moment in the day, creating a natural rhythm that feels easy to slip into and difficult to leave behind.

An infinity edge, an open sky and nowhere in particular to be.



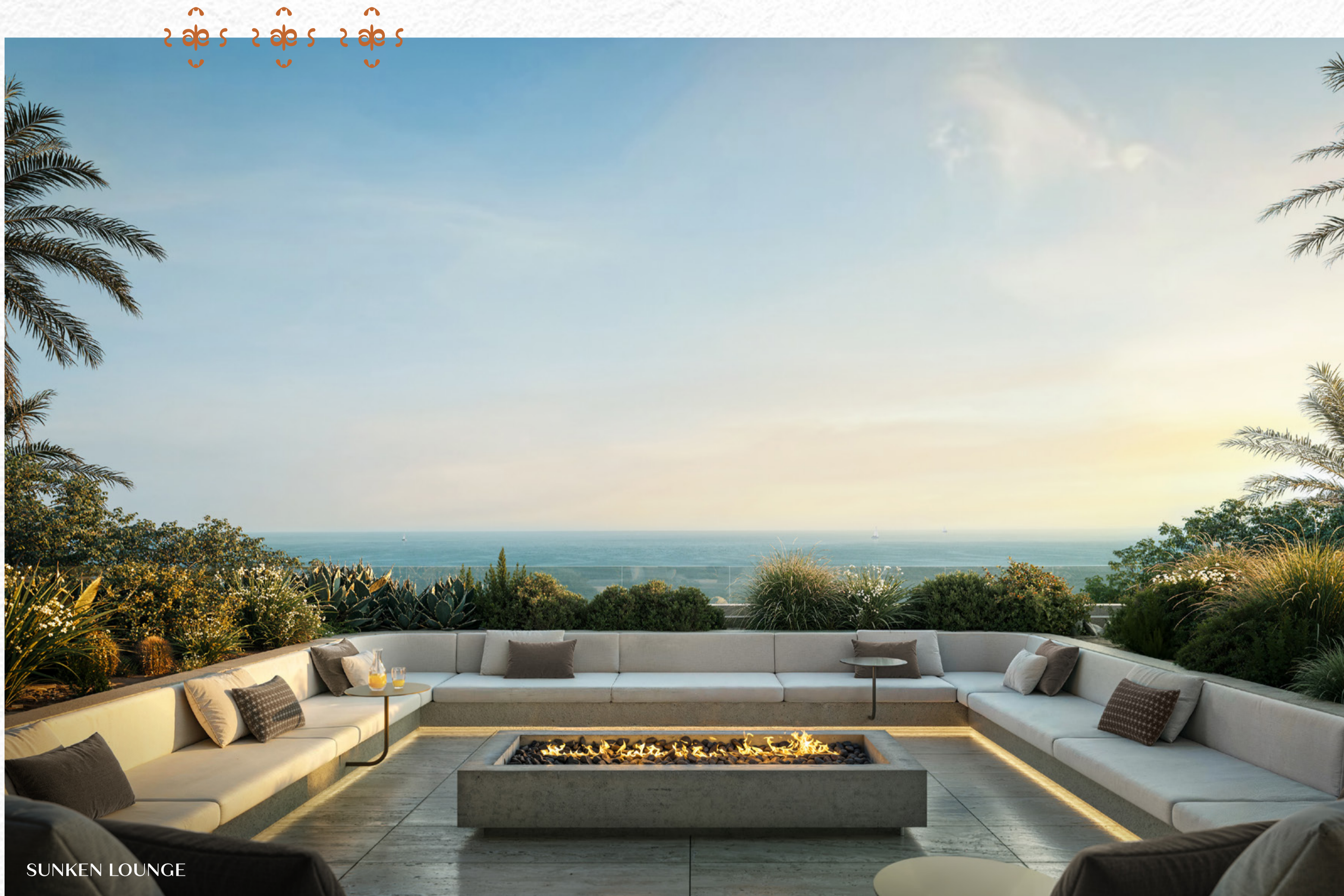

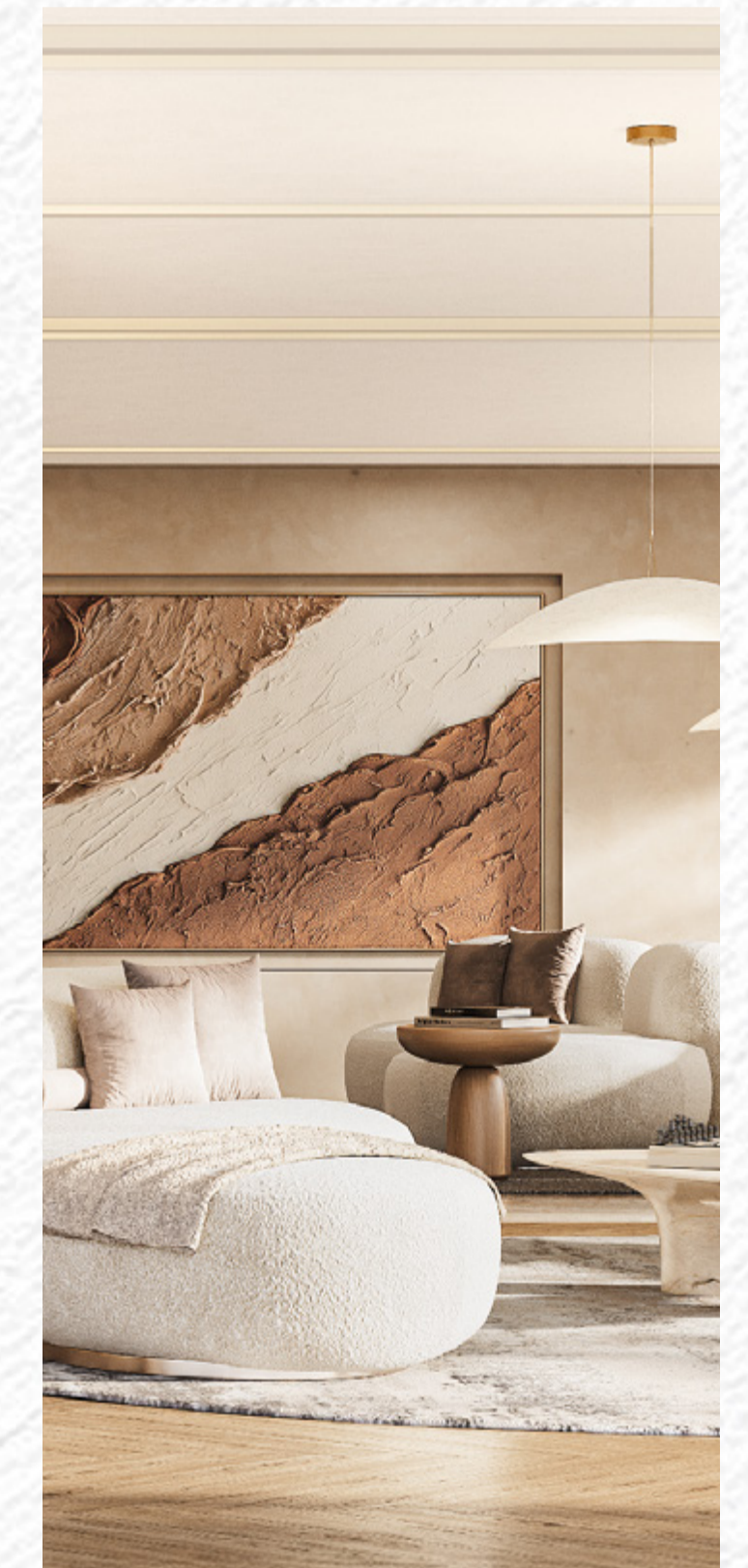
## A Room for Living

# Built Into The Day

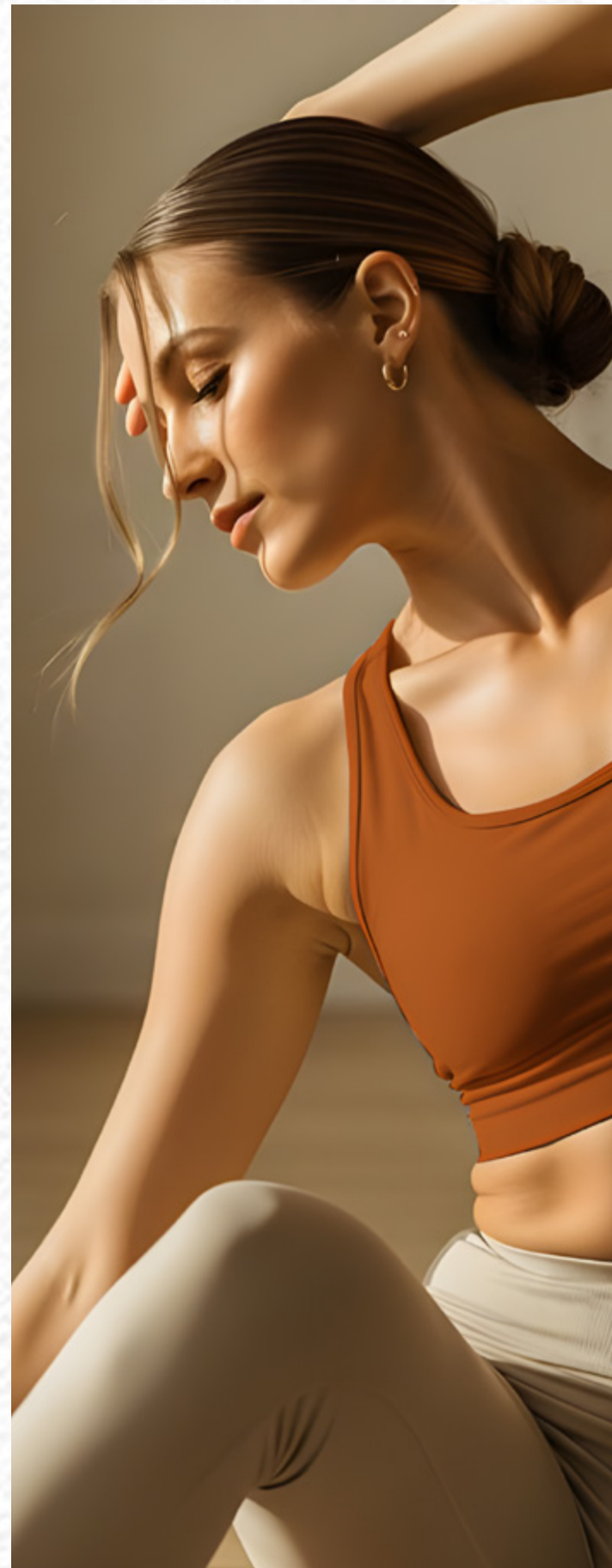
Sea views, natural light and the kind of space you don't have to talk yourself into.

Whether it's a quick session before work, a longer workout at the weekend or the occasional class with neighbours, it's the kind of space that quickly becomes part of the weekly routine.

Sometimes the most productive thing you can do is slow down for a while.

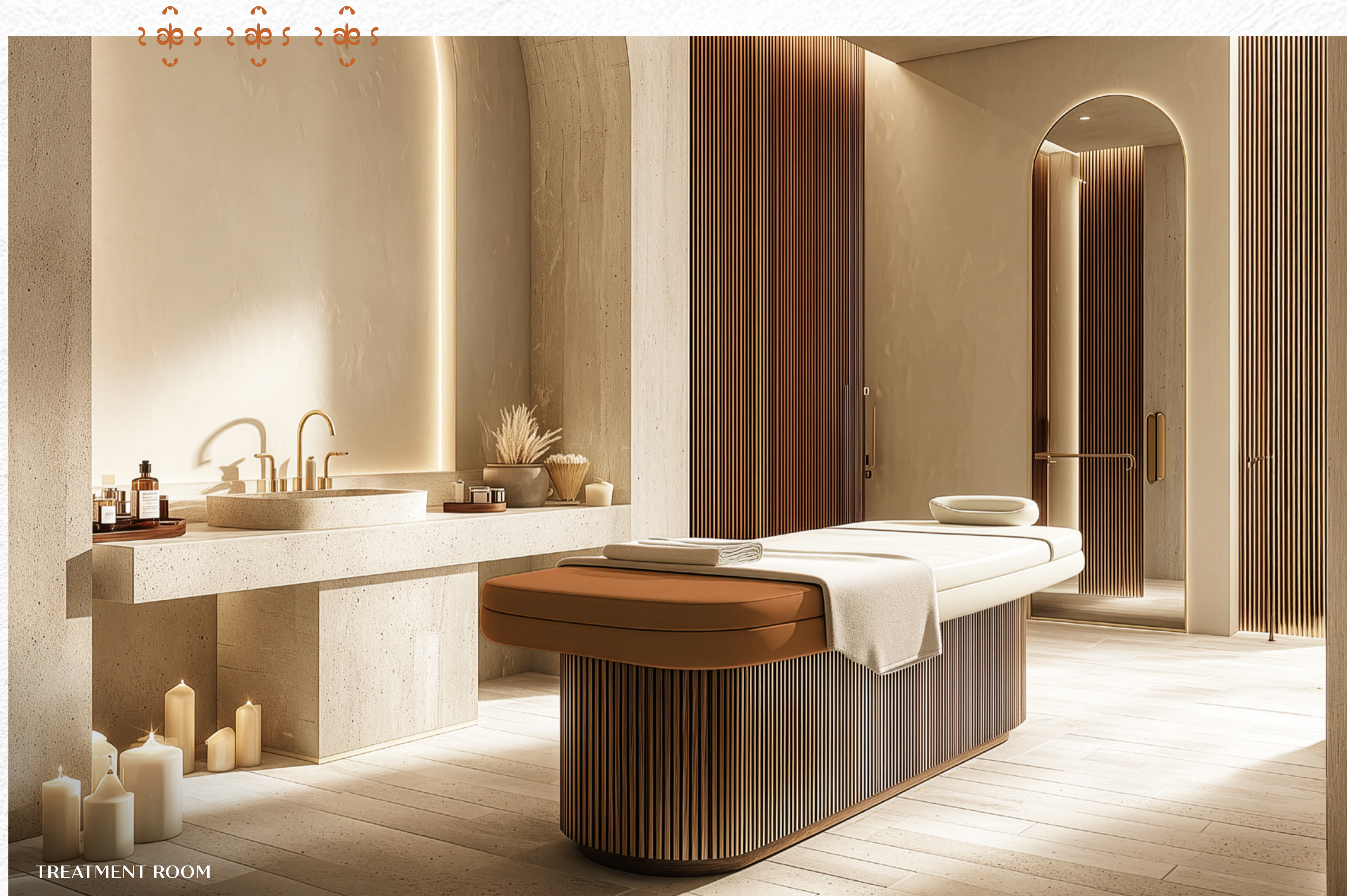
## An Hour Off

Soft light, quiet surroundings and a door that closes behind you.

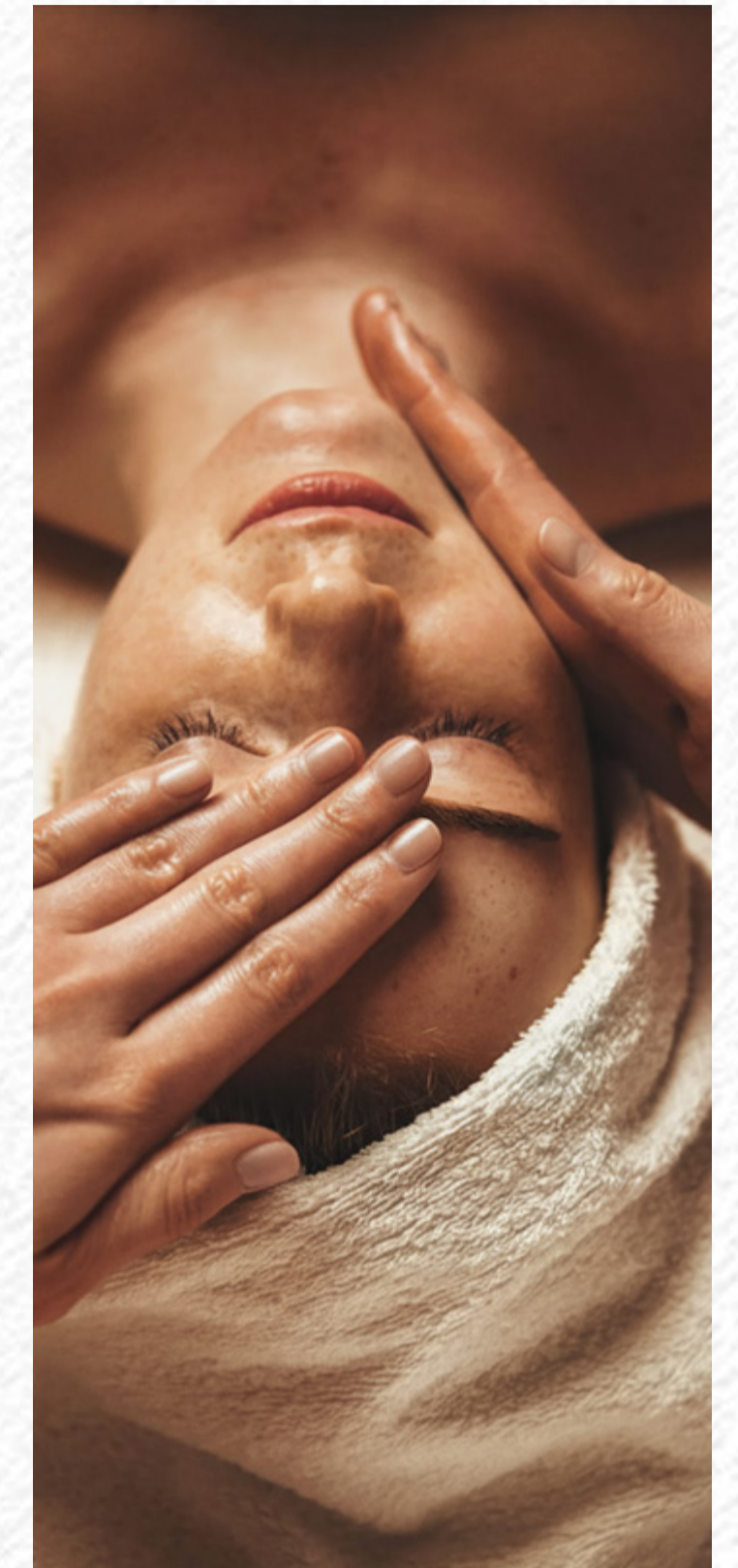

ROOFTOP LOUNGE & PADEL COURT

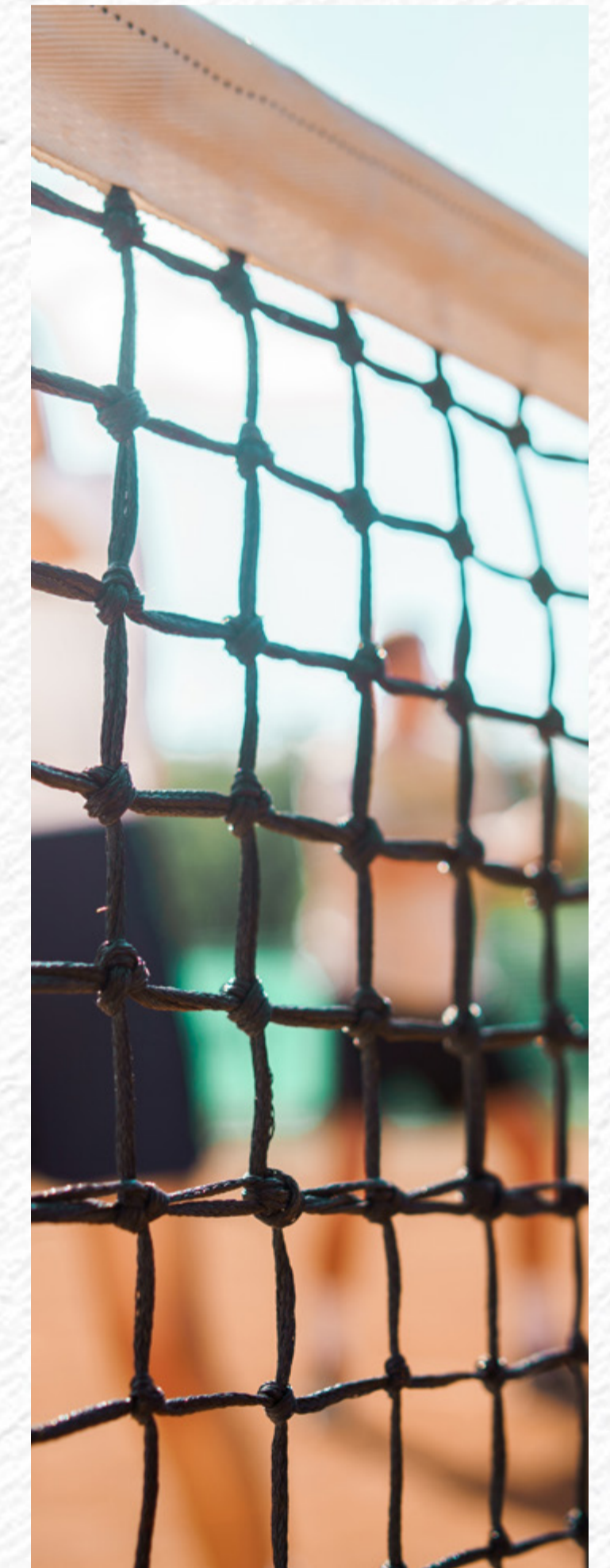
## A Game in the Sky

## Designed to be Lived in

The residences at SOMA. Oak tones, tactile stone and the southern light that finds its way into every room.



Designed by XBD Collective, the interiors take their cues from contemporary European living. Oak tones, tactile stone, soft palettes and restrained detailing create homes that feel effortless rather than overdesigned. Floor-to-ceiling glazing and expansive balconies draw the horizon into everyday life. Three-metre ceilings give each room a generous, unhurried sense of space, while acoustic glazing keeps the city outside where it belongs.

Layouts are quietly considered. Generous where life happens, efficient where it doesn't. Nothing competes for attention. Everything simply feels right.

## Living, Naturally

The living spaces at SOMA.  
Open-plan, and built for the long  
hours of an afternoon.



Morning light across the dining table. Evenings that move easily between the kitchen, the balcony and whoever happens to stay for one more drink. Open layouts, generous glazing and the kind of flow that makes a small dinner feel relaxed and a larger gathering feel effortless.

### 1-BEDROOM RESIDENCES

A bright, generous one-bedroom residence for those who want less, done properly. Open-plan living and a private terrace create a home where mornings begin slowly, meals last longer and everyday life naturally extends outdoors.

### 2-BEDROOM RESIDENCES

Designed for those who enjoy having people around, the two-bedroom residences offer generous living spaces that naturally bring people together. Long lunches, friends staying the weekend or an extra room that adapts as life does. Spacious, flexible and filled with natural light, they make hosting feel easy.

# Crafted for Gathering

The kitchen at SOMA. An oversized island, morning light and room for people to stay a little longer.



Morning coffee before the world wakes up. A meal shared with family. Conversations that continue long after dinner is finished. Open to the living and dining spaces, the kitchen sits at the centre of everyday life.

Porcelain surfaces, warm timber cabinetry and integrated Bosch appliances create a kitchen that feels quietly refined, easy to live with and centred around the moments that bring people together.

## Slow Mornings. Easy Evenings.

The bedrooms at SOMA. Warm tones, softened lighting and walls that hold the silence.



Acoustic glazing pulls the city out of the room. The light is soft from the moment you wake until the moment you turn it off. Natural textures, quiet comfort and the kind of bed you don't want to leave on a Sunday.

Integrated wardrobes and considered storage keep the floor clear and the eye uncluttered. A long window frames the sky from the bed. A room to settle in, switch off and stay awhile.

The duplexes at SOMA. Double-height living spaces and a greater sense of openness throughout.



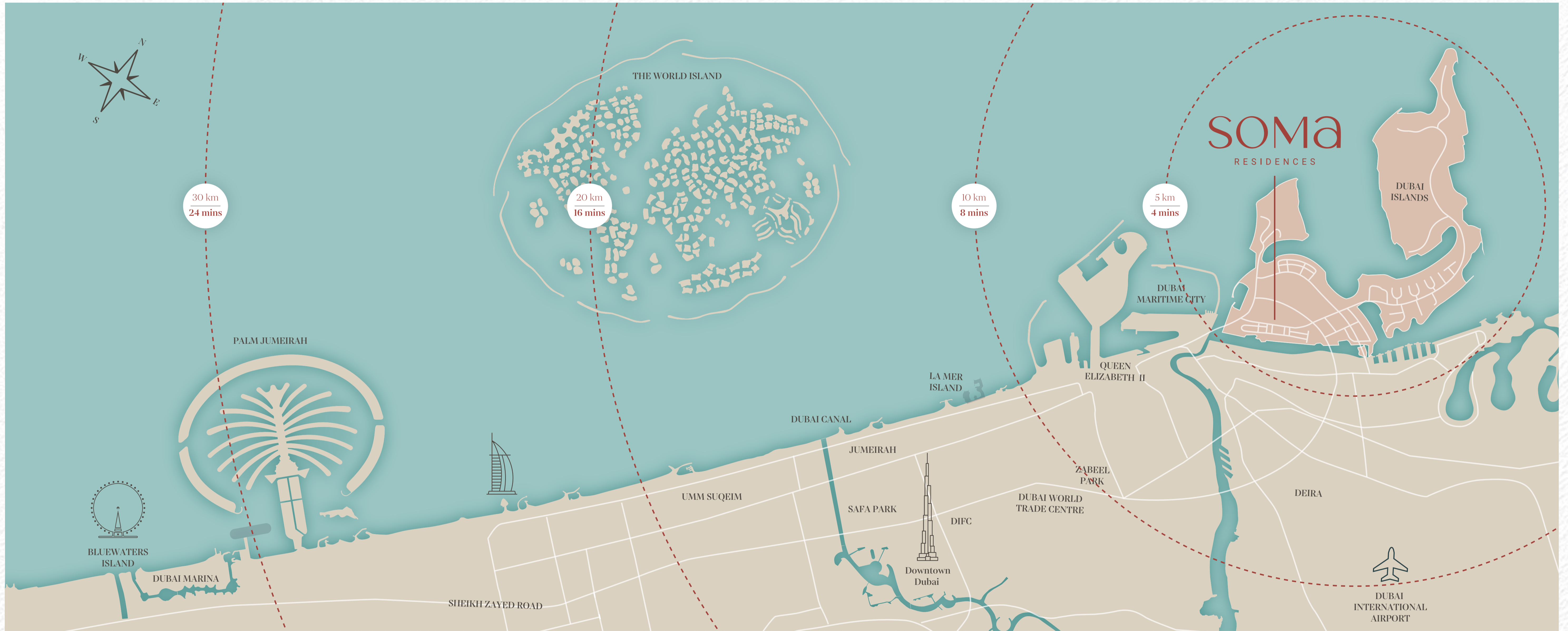
Everything that defines SOMA, with a little more space around it. Generous proportions on the living level, the bedrooms upstairs.
